The role will also take on a commercial element under the guidance of the shipbrokers.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Daily communication with the Owner and Charterer for fixtures which have been confirmed by the brokerage team including adherence to time-bars.
- Conduct performance and cost monitoring analysis and present the information to the Broker for regular KPI meetings for the customer.
- Perform demurrage (or sea-time/port-time) analysis and manage any other claims which we receive.
- Manage and maintain the databases used in the Company, this includes the port information, product information and vessel databases.
- Manage the file storage system.
- Provide any additional support and information as Broker request.
- Out-of-hours operational support and cover.
