EXAMINATION RULES

Before entering the exam room:

- Bring your photo identification and student registration number with you.
- Candidates arriving more than 30 minutes late will not be admitted.
- You must provide your own equipment (pens, pencils, calculators etc.) for the examination, which must be completed in blue or black pen.
- No electronic devices whatsoever will be allowed. This includes cell phones/pagers and smart watches. Being found with a phone during the examination (even if it is switched off) will result in your disqualification.

During the exam

- Follow the instructions on the answer booklets.
 Do not turn over the question paper until instructed to do so.
- You may not leave your place during the examination without the permission of the Invigilator.
- Follow all instructions given to you by the Invigilator.
- You may only leave the examination room early after the first 40 minutes has elapsed and you may not leave the room during the last 15 minutes of the examination.
- Only non-programmable calculators may be used.
- Dictionaries are not allowed.
- No smoking or food is permitted in the examination room.
- Spare paper is not permitted. You may only write on your examination answer booklet. Anything you don't want marked needs to be crossed out before the end of the examination. Do not remove any pages from your answer booklet(s).
- The use of correction fluid is not permitted.

- No one may leave the room without handing their answer booklet and question paper to the Invigilator.
- At the end of the examination, you may not leave unless instructed to do so.
- Invigilators will issue necessary instructions and manage the exam but will not enter into any discussion with candidates whatsoever. Attempts to communicate with other candidates will be treated as malpractice ('cheating') and will be reported and may be grounds for disqualification.
